Three Truths to be Extravagantly Blessed

1. The Principle of **OWNERSHIP**.

Malachi 3:10 "Bring all the tithes into the storehouse."

Matthew 6:31-33 Jesus said, "So don't worry about these things, saying, 'What will we eat? What will we drink? What will we wear?' These things dominate the thoughts of unbelievers, but your heavenly Father already knows all your needs. Seek the Kingdom of God above all else, and live righteously, and he will give you everything you need."

God extravagantly blesses the life that fully belongs to Him.

1 Timothy 6:17 "Command those who are rich in this present world not to be arrogant nor to put their hope in wealth, which is so uncertain, but to put their hope in God, who richly provides us with everything for our enjoyment."

I will not trust in riches, but in Him who richly provides.

Psalm 24:1 "The earth is the Lord's, and everything in it, the world and all who live in it."

Deuteronomy 8:17-18 "You might say to yourself, 'I am rich because of my own power and strength,' but remember the Lord your God! It is he who gives you the power to become rich."

Romans 6:13: "Give yourselves completely to God... use your whole body as an instrument to do what is right for the glory of God."

2 Corinthians 8:5 "They first gave themselves to the Lord before they gave their money. This is what God wants."

2. The Practice of OFFERING.

Malachi 3:8 "Should people cheat God? Yet you have cheated me! But you ask, 'What do You mean? When did we ever cheat You?' You have cheated me of the tithes and offerings due to Me."

Deuteronomy 28:15 "If you do not obey the Lord your God and carefully follow all His commands and laws I am giving you today, all these curses will come upon you and stay."

Proverbs 3:9-10: "Honor the LORD with your wealth, with the firstfruits of all your crops; then your barns will be filled to overflowing, and your vats will brim over with new wine."

You can give without being surrendered to God, but you cannot be surrendered to God without giving.

1 Timothy 6:18-19 "Tell those who are rich to do good - to be rich in good works. And tell them they should be happy to give and ready to share. By doing this, they will be saving up a treasure for themselves. And that treasure will be a strong foundation on which their future life will be built. They will be able to have the life that is true life."
