Psalm 126:5-6 “Those who sow in tears shall reap in joy. He who continually goes forth weeping, bearing seed for sowing, shall doubtless come again with rejoicing, bringing his sheaves with him.”

THREE FACTORS YOU NEED TO REACH YOUR HARVEST

1. Direction.

Psalm 126:5 “He who **GOES FORTH** bearing seed for sowing...”

Genesis 1:28 “God blessed them and said, “Be fruitful and multiply.”

John 10:10 “My purpose is to give life in all its fullness...more and better life than you ever dreamed of.”

John 15:8 “When you produce much fruit, you are My true disciples. This brings great glory to My Father.”

**Since fruitfulness is your
Divine destiny,
you must move your life in the
direction of fruitfulness.**

Genesis 12:2-3 “I will bless you and make you famous, and you will be a blessing to others. All the families on earth will be blessed through you.”

Fruit is always meant to be shared.

**Don't focus on yourself.
Focus on impact.**

Mark 8:35 “If you try to hang on to your life, you will lose it. But if you give up your life for My sake and for the sake of the Good News, you will save it.”

Mark 10:45 “The Son of Man did not come for people to serve Him. He came to serve others and to give His life to save many people.”

2. Discipline.

Psalm 126:5 “He who
CONTINUALLY goes forth
weeping...”

Proverbs 16:9 “Human beings plan
their lives. But the Lord decides
where their steps will take them.”

**Are you more interested in
fulfilling your desires or fulfilling
your destiny?**

James 4:13-16 “Look here, you who
say, ‘Today or tomorrow we are
going to a certain town and will stay
there a year. We will do business
there and make a profit.’ How do
you know what your life will be like
tomorrow? Your life is like the
morning fog - it’s here a little while,
then it’s gone. What you ought to

say is, 'If the Lord wants us to, we will live and do this or that.'

Otherwise you are boasting about your own pretentious plans, and all such boasting is evil."

Luke 12:15 "Life is not measured by how much you own."

Mark 8:36 "What do you benefit if you gain the whole world but lose your own soul?"

Psalms 25:12-13 "When people choose to follow the Lord, He shows them the best way to live. They will enjoy good things, and their children will get the land God promised."

Make destiny-based decisions, not desire-based decisions.

3. Determination.

Psalm 126:6 “Those who sow in tears shall reap in joy. He will **DOUBTLESS** come again with rejoicing, bringing his sheaves with him.”

2 Corinthians 1:19-21 “Jesus Christ, the Son of God, does not waver between ‘Yes’ and ‘No.’ He is God’s ultimate ‘Yes,’ He always does what He says. For all of God’s promises have been fulfilled in Christ with a resounding ‘Yes!’ And through Christ, our ‘Amen’ (which means ‘Yes’) ascends to God for His glory.”

2 Corinthians 9:10 “He who supplies seed to the sower and bread for food will supply and multiply your seed for sowing and increase the harvest of your righteousness.”

Galatians 6:7, 9 “You will always harvest what you plant. So let’s not get tired of doing what is good. At just the right time we will reap a harvest of blessing if we don’t give up.”
