THE THREE PHASES OF OUR REDEMPTION

1. RESCUE.

2 Corinthians 1:10 “God delivered us.”

Genesis 7:23 “The only people who survived were Noah and those with

him in the boat.”

Colossians 1:13-14 “God has rescued us from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son He loves, in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.”

**Your history cannot prevent your
destiny when Jesus redeems you!
When your past is under His blood
your future is under His control.**

Ephesians 1:7-8, 13-14 “In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God’s grace that He lavished on us. When you believed, you were marked in Him

with a seal, the promised Holy Spirit, who is a deposit guaranteeing our inheritance until the redemption of those who are God's possession - to the praise of His glory.”

Titus 2:11-14 “For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men. It teaches us to say ‘No’ to ungodliness and worldly passions, and to live self-controlled, upright and godly lives in this present age, **while we wait for the blessed hope - the glorious appearing of our great God and Savior, Jesus Christ, who gave Himself for us to redeem us from all wickedness** and to purify for Himself a people that are His

very own, eager to do what is good.”

Grace doesn't just free us from the penalty of sin. It also frees us from the power of sin. Grace gives us the power to say NO to sin.

2. REFINING.

2 Corinthians 1:10 “God does deliver us.”

Romans 5:3-5 “We rejoice in our sufferings, knowing that suffering produces endurance, and endurance produces character, and **character produces hope**, and hope does not put us to shame.”

1 Peter 1:3-7 “All praise to God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. It is by His great mercy that we have been born again, because God raised Jesus Christ from the dead. Now we live with great expectation, and we have a priceless inheritance - an inheritance

that is kept in heaven for you, pure and undefiled, beyond the reach of change and decay. And through your faith, God is protecting you by His power until you receive this salvation, which is ready to be revealed on the last day for all to see. So be truly glad. There is wonderful joy ahead, even though you must endure many trials for a little while. These trials will show that your faith is genuine. It is being tested as fire tests and purifies gold - though your faith is far more precious than mere gold. So when your faith remains strong through many trials, it will bring you much praise and glory and honor on the day when Jesus Christ is revealed

to the whole world.”

1 Peter 1:13-16 “So prepare your minds for action and exercise self-control. Put all your hope in the gracious salvation that will come to you when Jesus Christ is revealed to the world. So you must live as God’s obedient children. Don’t slip back into your old ways of living to satisfy your own desires. You didn’t know

any better then. But now you must be holy in everything you do, just as God who chose you is holy. For the Scriptures say, ‘You must be holy because I am holy.’”

Romans 8:18-19 “Yet what we suffer now is nothing compared to the glory He will reveal to us later. For all creation is waiting eagerly for that future day when God will reveal who His children really are.”

3. REWARD.

2 Corinthians 1:10 “God will still deliver us.”

Genesis 8:1 “But God remembered Noah...”

Isaiah 49:13-16 “Sing for joy, O heavens! Rejoice, O earth! Burst into song, O mountains! For the Lord has comforted His people and will have compassion on them in their suffering. Yet Jerusalem says, ‘The Lord has deserted us; the Lord has forgotten us.’ Never! Can a mother forget her nursing child? Can she feel no love for the child she has borne? But even if that were possible, I would not forget you! See,

I have written your name on the palms of My hands.”

1 Corinthians 1:7-9 “...as you eagerly wait for the return of our Lord Jesus Christ. He will keep you strong to the end so that you will be free from all blame on the day when our Lord Jesus Christ returns. God will do this, for He is faithful to do what He says, and He has invited you into partnership with His Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.”

Hebrews 6:10-11 “God is not unjust; He will not forget your work and the love you have shown Him as you have helped His people and continue to help them. We want

each of you to show this same diligence to the very end, so that what you hope for may be fully realized.”

Matthew 16:27 “The Son of Man is going to come in His Father’s glory with His angels, and then He will reward each person according to what they have done.”
