Acts 3:1-10 The Crippled Man Who Was Stuck At The Gate

## **THREE STEPS TO GO FROM STUCK TO START**

### **1. Reassess Your PROBLEM.**

Acts 3:2 “Now a man crippled from birth...”

Psalm 11:3 “If the foundations are destroyed, what can the righteous do?”

Acts 3:9-10: “The people recognized him as the same man who used to sit begging at the temple gate.”

**You can't hold onto your problem  
and make progress at the same time.**

1 Corinthians 6:11 “Some of you were once like that. But you were cleansed; you were made holy; you were made right with God by calling on the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and by the Spirit of our God.”

## 2. Revise Your POSITION.

Acts 3:2 “The crippled man was being carried to the temple gate called Beautiful, where he was put every day to beg from those going into the temple courts.”

Ephesians 2:6-8: “For He raised us from the dead along with Christ and seated us with Him in the heavenly realms because we are united with Christ Jesus. So God can point to us in all future ages as examples of the incredible wealth of His grace and kindness toward us, as shown in all He has done for us who are united with Christ Jesus. God saved you by His grace when you believed. And you can't take credit for this; it is a

gift from God.”

**Release the past, so the past can  
release you.**

Matthew 9:12-13 “Healthy people don’t need a doctor - sick people do. For I have come to call not those who think they are righteous, but those who know they are sinners.”

**Faith is born at the point  
of human limitation.**

**Faith erupts when man’s  
ability fails.**

Hebrews 10:22 “Let us draw near to God with a sincere heart in full assurance of faith...”

### 3. Release Your PROGRESS.

Acts 3:7-8 “Taking him by the right hand, he (Peter) helped him up, and instantly the man's feet and ankles became strong. He jumped to his feet and began to walk. Then he went with them into the temple courts, walking and jumping, and praising God.”

**The grace of God is bigger  
than your need.**

2 Corinthians 8:9 “You know the generous grace of our Lord Jesus Christ. Though He was rich, yet for your sakes He became poor, so that by His poverty He could make you rich.”

**I am not a product of my past. I am a product of the grace of God.**

2 Corinthians 10:4 “The weapons we fight with are not the weapons of the world. On the contrary, they have divine power to demolish strongholds.”
