7:11-17**

**Three Truths to Carry
You from Defeat to
Dominion**

**1. God DRIVES OUT
Defeat.**

Luke 7:12 “As they approached the village gate, they met a funeral procession.”

Acts 2:24 “But God raised Him from the dead, freeing Him from the agony of death, because it was impossible for death to keep its hold on Him.”

Ephesians 2:1, 4-6 “Once you were dead because of your disobedience and your many sins. But God is so rich in mercy, and He loved us so much, that even though we were dead because of our sins, He gave us life when He raised Christ from the dead. (It is only by God’s grace that you have been saved!) For He raised us from the dead along with Christ and seated us with Him in the heavenly realms because we are united with Christ Jesus.”

*When Life meets Death, Life
always wins.*

Philippians 2:9-11 “Therefore, God elevated Him to the place of highest honor and gave Him the name above all other names,

that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue declare that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.”

Ephesians 1:19-22 “I also pray that you will understand the incredible greatness of God’s power for us who believe Him. This is the same mighty power that raised Christ from the dead and seated Him in the place of honor at God’s right hand in the heavenly realms. Now He is far above any ruler or authority or power or leader or anything else - not only in this world but also in the world to come. God has put all things under the authority of Christ and has made Him head

over all things for the benefit of the church.”

2. God DELIVERS YOU from Defeat.

Luke 7:13-14 “When Jesus saw her, His heart overflowed with compassion. He said to her, ‘Don’t cry.’ Then He went over and touched the coffin.”

Lamentations 3:21-23 “Yet I still dare to hope when I remember this: The faithful love of the Lord **never ends!** His mercies never cease. Great is His faithfulness; His mercies begin afresh each morning.”

Luke 6:35 “God in heaven is good even to people who are unthankful and cruel.”

Matthew 5:45 “For God gives His sunlight to both the evil and the good, and He sends rain on the just and the unjust alike.”

Matthew 7:11 “And if you hard-hearted, sinful men know how to give good gifts to your children, won’t your Father in heaven even more certainly give good gifts to those who ask Him for them?”

God’s love never ends!

Psalm 57:10 “Your unfailing love is as high as the heavens. Your faithfulness reaches to the clouds.”

Psalm 18:16-19 “He reached down from heaven and rescued

me; He drew me out of deep waters. He rescued me from my powerful enemies, from those who hated me and were too strong for me. They attacked me at a moment when I was in distress, but the Lord supported me. He led me to a place of safety; He rescued me because He delights in me.”

3. God has DOMINION over Defeat.

Luke 7:14-15 “He said, ‘Young man, I tell you: Get up.’ The dead son sat up and began talking.”

Isaiah 9:6-7 “The government will rest on His shoulders. And He will be called: Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God,

Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. His government and its peace will never end.”

Revelation 22:13 “I am the Alpha and the Omega, the First and the Last, the Beginning and the End.”

Jude 1:24-25 “Now to Him who is able to keep you from stumbling and to present you blameless before the presence of His glory with great joy, to the only God, our Savior, through Jesus Christ our Lord, be glory, majesty, dominion, and authority, before all time and now and forever. Amen.”

Proverbs 16:4 “The Lord works out everything to its proper end.”
