Luke 4:18-19 "Jesus said, 'The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, for He has anointed Me to bring Good News to the poor. He has sent Me to proclaim that captives will be released, that the blind will see, that the oppressed will be set free, and that the time of the Lord's favor has come.'"

Romans 5:12 "When Adam sinned, sin entered the world. Adam's sin brought death, so death spread to everyone, for everyone sinned."

Romans 6:23 "For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life through Christ Jesus our Lord."

Three Ways Jesus Breaks the Bondage of Sin

John 8:3-11 The woman caught in adultery

1. Jesus delivers us from the PAIN of sin.

John 8:3 "The teachers of the law and the Pharisees brought in a woman caught in adultery. They made her stand before the group..."

Proverbs 6:27-28 "If you drop a hot coal in your lap, your clothes will be burned. If you step on one, your feet will be burned."

Hebrews 11:25 "...the fleeting pleasures of sin."

Hosea 8:7 "They sow the wind and reap the whirlwind."

Acts 3:19-20 "Now repent of your sins and turn to God, so that your sins may be wiped away. Then times of refreshment will come from the presence of the Lord."

2. Jesus delivers us from the PENALTY of sin.

John 8:10-11 "Jesus straightened up and asked her, 'Woman, where are they? Has no one condemned you?' 'No one, sir,' she said. 'Then neither do I condemn you,' Jesus declared."

John 3:16 "For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life."

Psalms 13:5 David wrote, "I trust in your unfailing love."

Romans 8 35-39 "Paul wrote, 'Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.'"

1 Peter 4:8 Peter wrote, "Love covers a multitude of sins."

Titus 3:4-6 "When God our Savior revealed His kindness and love, He saved us, not because of the righteous things we had done, but because of His mercy. He washed away our sins, giving us a new birth and new life through the Holy Spirit."

Ephesians 1:7 "In Christ we are made free by His blood sacrifice. We have forgiveness of sins because of God's rich grace."

1 John 1:9 "But if we confess our sins to Him, He can be depended on to forgive us and to cleanse us from every wrong. And it is perfectly proper for God to do this for us because Christ died to wash away our sins."

3. Jesus delivers us from the POWER of sin.

John 8:11 "Jesus told the woman, 'Go now and leave your life of sin.'"

Matthew 1:21 "You are to name Him Jesus, for He will save His people from their sins."

Romans 8:1-2 "So now there is no condemnation for those who belong to Christ Jesus. And because you belong to Him, the power of the life-giving Spirit has freed you from the power of sin that leads to death."

Pray this prayer today:

“Dear Lord, I know I don’t deserve Your mercy and grace, but I thank You that You did not leave me in sin and shame. Thank You that You want to redeem me and forgive me, not punish and expose me. Thank You for shedding Your blood on the cross so that I could be delivered! Forgive me of my sin and deliver me from the pain, the penalty, and the power of sin. I will not trust in anything other than Your grace to forgive me. Come into my life and live in me. I dedicate my life to You now, in Jesus’ name. Amen.”
