Luke 5 The Miraculous Catch of Fish

Luke 5:10-11 "And Jesus said to Simon, 'Do not be afraid; from now on you will be catching men.' And when they had brought their boats to land, they left everything and followed Him."

Three Steps to More Grace

1. More Grace Starts When God is WITH US.

Luke 5:3 "Jesus got into the boat."

2 Corinthians 8:9 "You know the generous grace of our Lord Jesus Christ. Though He was rich, yet for your sakes He became poor, so that by His poverty He could make you rich."

1 Corinthians 15:9-10 "I am the least of the apostles, unworthy to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the church of God. But by the grace of God I am what I am, and His grace to me has not been in vain. In fact, I worked harder than all of them - yet not I, but the grace of God with me."

HOPE opens the door for overflowing grace.

John 1:14 "The Word became flesh and made His dwelling among us. We have seen His glory, the glory of the One and only Son, who came from the Father, **full of grace** and truth."

2. More Grace Produces God's Work IN US.

Luke 5:5 "Simon answered, 'At Your word I will let down the nets.'"

HUMILITY accelerates the flow of grace in us.

Luke 5:9 "When Simon Peter saw it, he fell down at Jesus' knees, saying, 'Depart from me, for I am a sinful man, O Lord.'"

John 1:16 "For from His fullness we have all received, **grace upon grace.**"

True grace transforms our lives.

Colossians 1:6 "This same Gospel...is bearing fruit everywhere by changing lives, just as it changed your lives from the day you first heard and **understood the truth about God's wonderful grace.**"

Jude 1:4 "Some people...will be judged guilty. They are against God and have **changed the grace of our God into a reason for sexual sin.** They also refuse to accept Jesus Christ, our only Master and Lord."

Titus 2:11-12 "For the grace of God has appeared that offers salvation to all people. It teaches us to say 'No' to ungodliness and worldly passions, and to live self-controlled, upright and godly lives in this present age."

3. More Grace Results in God Working THROUGH US.

Luke 5:10 "Jesus said to Simon, 'Do not be afraid; from now on you will be catching men.'"

Acts 11:20-23 "There were some men who came to Antioch and began to speak to the Greeks too, proclaiming the good news of the Lord Jesus. The hand of the Lord was with them, and a great number who believed turned to the Lord. A report about them came to the attention of the church in Jerusalem, and they sent Barnabas to Antioch. When he came and **saw the grace of God**, he rejoiced and encouraged them all to remain true to the Lord with devoted hearts."

HARVEST is always the outcome of more grace.

Ephesians 4:7 "Each one of us has received a gift of grace. These gifts are given to us by Christ."

2 Corinthians 9:8, 13-15 "And God is able to make **all grace abound toward you**, that you, always having all sufficiency in all things, may have an abundance for every good work. As a result of your ministry, they will give glory to God. And they will pray for you with deep affection because of **the overflowing grace God has given to you**. Thank God for this gift too wonderful for words!"
